



2008 Maple Vineyard Zinfandel

This is our flagship Zinfandel and the 2008 lives up to, and exceeds our lofty expectations. The Maple Vineyard sits up on a bench above Dry Creek Valley on the East side, and is farmed utilizing old world farming techniques by Tom and Tina Maple. The vineyard contains many old vines, and is head pruned and dry farmed, making for an intense Dry Creek Valley Zinfandel. This wine is signature Maple Vineyards with tons of lush fruit, cranberry, blackberries, and black cherry. Sweet vanilla oak, cola, and cinnamon finish out this well balanced wine.
