This wine is the best of the best Zin that we have to offer. This year the best and most delicious 9-barrels of Zinfandel in our cellar were chosen and blended to create this otherworldly nectar. The nose is fruit driven with fresh plum, bing cherry, spicy peppercorn and cranberry. The mouthfeel is supple, yet well structured with gobs of dense ripe Dry Creek Zin fruit, and hints of dark chocolate, fresh strawberries, with a long rhubarb pie finish.
